HANDLING AND APPLICATION

PREPARATION:

1. Clean surface thoroughly and dry.
2. Sand surface with 220-320 grit sandpaper.
3. Blow or wipe off dust and re-clean.

MIXING:

Agitate thoroughly! Shake can vigorously for one minute after mixing ball rattles to ensure color uniformity and to prevent clogging. For best results, use only when can temperature is approximately 70°F (21°C).

APPLICATION:

1. Prime any bare metal with **Promax Primer**.
2. Mask adjacent areas to protect from overspray
3. If priming, sand with 320 grit sandpaper. Allow primer to dry 30 minutes before top coating with **Promax**.
4. If not priming, test a small area for compatibility.
5. Apply light “mist” coats, allowing 5-10 minutes between coats.
6. If applying **Promax Clear**, allow **Promax** to dry 3 hours before clear coating.

Note:

If clogging develops, remove spray button with a twisting motion and clean with material compliant with VOC regulations in your area. Do not stick pin or other object into can. Gently replace spray button with top of can and spray button pointed away from you.

After each use, turn can upside down and spray several seconds to clear spray tip.

STORAGE:

Promax should be stored in a cool dry place with adequate ventilation away from heat, sparks and flames. The shelf life for **Promax** is 3 years when stored under normal conditions.
